The 2025-2026 Discover Scholarship Sweepstakes Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR CREDIT CARD APPLICATION OR ACCOUNT NECESSARY. A PURCHASE, CREDIT CARD ACCOUNT, OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. Eligibility: The 2025-2026 Discover Scholarship Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") is open only to U.S. residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least 18 years of age or older (or the age of majority in their state of residence) at the time of entry (each, an "Entrant"). Administrator's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.

You will automatically receive one (1) entry into the applicable Entry Period drawing.

b. In the event of a dispute as to any registration, the authorized account holder of the email address used to register will be deemed to be the Entrant. The "authorized account holder" is the natural person assigned an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted address. Each potential winner may be required to show proof of being an authorized account holder.

- 5. Drawings: Administrator is an independent judging organization whose decisions as to the administration and operation of the Sweepstakes and the selection of the potential winners are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Administrator will randomly select the potential Sweepstakes winners from all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period, on or around the dates listed above in Rule 3. Non-winning entries will carryover into subsequent Entry Period drawings. The potential winners will be notified by email. Each potential winner (or parent/legal guardian if winner is a minor in his/her state of residence) will be required to sign and return a Declaration of Eligibility, Liability and Publicity Release ("Declaration") (except for residents in Tennessee where a Publicity Release is not required) and an IRS Form W-9 which must be received by Administrator within ten (10) days of the date of attempted notice by the Administrator to claim the applicable prize. If a potential winner of any prize cannot be contacted, fails to sign and return the Declaration within the required time period, fails to provide any other requested information within the required time period, fails to or is unable to select an eligible college or university, does not intend to or does not actually attend a participating college/university within one (1) year of winner notification/confirmation, or if the prize is returned as undeliverable, the potential winner forfeits the applicable prize. Receiving a prize is contingent upon compliance with these Official Rules. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor may award the applicable prize to an alternate winner by random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries. There will be alternate drawings that will be held for each prize, until each prize is awarded. Where a confirmed winner fails to enter college within one year, they will forfeit the prize. Sponsor will not take any further actions to award this prize. Prizes will be fulfilled within approximately 60 days after the conclusion of the Sweepstakes.
- **6. Prizes:** TWELVE (12) PRIZES (One (1) awarded per Entry Period): A \$5,000 scholarship check made payable to the eligible institution of higher education as reflected in the winner's Declaration. A winner forfeits the prize if they do not attend a participating

college/university within one (1) year of notification/winner confirmation. Approximate Retail Value ("ARV"): \$5,000.

Prizes are non-transferable and no substitution will be made except as provided herein at the Sponsor's sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason. Winners will receive an IRS Form 1099-MISC reporting the entire scholarship check prize. Winners are responsible for all taxes and fees associated with prize receipt and/or use. See **Topic no. 421** that details IRS rules associated with scholarships.

Odds of winning a prize depend on the number of eligible entries received during the applicable Entry Period, during the Promotion Period. Limit: one (1) prize per household. Total ARV of all prizes: \$60,000.

- **7. General Conditions:** Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Sweepstakes for any reason, including if any fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other factor impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Sweepstakes, or any event or cause beyond Sponsor's control (e.g. events such as natural calamities, national emergencies, wide spread illnesses, declarations of war, acts of God, acts of terrorism) interferes with any aspect of the Sweepstakes, including but not limited to fulfillment of the prize(s), as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In such an event, Sponsor, in its sole discretion, may elect to hold a random drawing from among all eligible entries received up to the date of discontinuance and may modify the prizes offered herein. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes or to be acting in violation of the Official Rules of this or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or

disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately undermine the legitimate operation of the Sweepstakes may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

Limitations of Liability: The Released Parties are not responsible for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by Entrants, printing errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Sweepstakes; (2) technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited to malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections in network hardware or software; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Sweepstakes; (4) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Sweepstakes or the processing of entries; (5) late, lost, undeliverable, damaged or stolen mail; or (6) any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from Entrant's participation in the Sweepstakes or receipt or use or misuse of any prize. If for any reason an Entrant's entry is confirmed to have been erroneously deleted, lost, or otherwise destroyed or corrupted, Entrant's sole remedy is another entry in the Sweepstakes, if it is possible. Disputes: Except where prohibited, Entrant agrees that: (1) any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of or connected with this Sweepstakes or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan (Southern Division) or the appropriate Michigan State Court located in Oakland County, Michigan; (2) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this Sweepstakes, but in no event attorneys' fees; and (3) under no circumstances will Entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and Entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, indirect, punitive, incidental and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the Entrant and Sponsor in connection with the Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Michigan without giving effect to any choice of law

or conflict of law rules (whether of the State of Michigan or any other jurisdiction), which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than the State of Michigan.
